SENATE BILL #35

TITLE: SUPPORT OF BLACK CULTURE CENTER

- WHEREAS: Black American culture is an integral sector of our nation's heritage; and
- WHEREAS: There would be significant educational merit to the student body in a Black Culture Center; and
- WHEREAS: We recognize the financial limitations of any single organization in supporting such a center; and
- WHEREAS: A part of the Student Activity Fee Reserve Fund is in bonds which earn interest; and
- WHEREAS: The President of the Student Body recommends the following:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:

The Government of the Student Body Senate stands in support of the proposed Black Culture Center and encourages all other campus organizations and the University community to provide moral and financial assistance to this project.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED THAT:

Senate bill #23 of April 29, 1969 be made null and void.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED THAT:

The interest from the STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE RESERVE FUND be placed in the Alumni Achievement Fund for the Black Culture Center Corporation for a three year period including interest payments of the Bond for the fiscal years 1968 through 1970.
